

GIBC Nursery Rules

1. All babies must be signed in.
2. All babies should be changed twice unless the parents do not wish you to change the baby.
3. No baby leaves the nursery hungry unless the parents do not wish you to feed their child.
4. All snacks must be approved by April (or current nursery director).
5. Only the person who signed the baby in will be allowed to pick the baby up.
6. Every parent leaving a baby in the nursery will be required to keep the nursery at least once a month.
7. The crib sheets must be taken off after each service and placed in the basket.
8. The crib sheets must be made back up before a baby is accepted in the nursery.
9. Nursery workers should be in the nursery at least 15 minutes before the service.
10. All nursery workers should be clean and neat.
11. All nursery workers should have manners and tact.
12. All nursery workers should leave personal problems at home and focus on watching the babies.
13. All other activities should be planned around the nursery schedule. Do NOT ask to change the schedule. Instead, change your other activity. The nursery is MORE important than anything else...ask the preacher!
14. All nursery problems need to go straight to Mrs. April (or current superintendent).
15. All nursery helpers need to be at least 7 years old. A nursery worker must be an adult of 17 years old or older. No helper under the age of 12 can carry an infant (6 months and down).
16. The potty chair should be washed out and put away after every service if it has been used.
17. No one leaves the nursery (have everything you need and go to bathroom before you go to the nursery).
18. Never ask someone else to take your place if you can't work in the nursery. (But this should be only in the case of emergency.)
